Exam Instructions

Please see below the instructions for completing your Masterclass exam. It consists of four parts:

- Part 1: a production schedule
- Part 2: a production budget
- Part 3: a bid letter
- Part 4: multiple choice questions (online exam)

Part 1

Using the provided script, the PIBS and the Agency schedule, your task is to create a production schedule which covers and meets all deadlines required by the Agency/Client and which will enable you to produce/deliver the film. The

scheduling template is available in your Learning Platform in the 'Exam' folder.

Part 2
Using the provided script, the PIBS, your production schedule & the example kit quotes, prepare a production budget. The budgeting template is in your Dropbox exam "Blank Templates" subfolder. The cover page of your budget must consist of your name as the producer. As a guide, the ballpark for this budget is £400k. Note that the kit quotes provided do not cover all the equipment the production might need - for example they omit DIT, Sound, Digislate & Walkies & should instead be viewed as a guide.

Part 3

Write a bid letter, outlining your budget & costs to the agency with reference to the PIBS. Please deliver ONE hard copy of Part 1, 2 & 3 to the APA office by 18.00 on Friday 28th February (office closes at 18:00 - address below). Please ensure your hard copy is clearly marked with your name & company in an envelope or clear polypocket. You will receive your results up to 4 weeks after the deadline closes.
